





J. J. LOUBSER

Telkens wanneer 'n onderwyser Grey-Kollege verlaat dan dink 'n mens nie net aan die persoon self nie maar ook aan een of ander spesiale eien-skap wat hy besit het en wat nou uit die skool-

lewe sal verdwyn. By Koos Pit, soos staflede hom al jarelank ken, sal daar geen twyfel bestaan oor wat hierdie besondere eienskap was nie: dis natuurlik die gawe wat hy besit om op 'n onverwagte oomblik met 'n onverwagte en blykbaar onlogiese sê-ding uit sy onuitputlike humorbron te voorskyn te kom.

Gewoonlik kon hy met 'n vrome gesig sy spitsvondighede kwyt raak en dis alleen wanneer jy na sy oë kyk dat jy begin besef dat hy besig is om met iemand of iets die gek te skeer. So was daar byvoorbeeld een onderwyser (sê maar Piet) wat maar taamlik suinig was, en toe daar op 'n keer besluit is om 'n sikspens toegang te vra vir 'n spesiale skolewedstryd, sê Oom Koos ewig ernstig: „Ek is nou jammer daaroor, want Piet sou graag die wedstryd gesien het en nou sal hy by die huis moet bly.”

En hoe nader dit aan die Sentraal-wedstryd kom, hoe meer opgewonde raak hy en hoe vinniger kom die onverwagte grappe.

Die seuns het hom lief gehad, want hulle waardeer die egte mens en hulle hou van 'n droë humorsin. En praat van droog: byna elke jaar, by die afskeidsfunksie, is daar een of ander matrikulant wat met sy „niem 'n lieë, drrroëë prrroefbuis” die saal laat skaterlag.

Niemand is onmisbaar nie en daar sal opvolgers wees wat net sulke goeie rugbyspanne produus, want Grey se rugby-tradisie is nie die van een man alleen nie; daar sal ander manne wees wat met dieselfde filosofiese uitkyk op sake help om die ewewig van die skool te bewaar; maar daar sal nooit 'n ander Koos Pit kom nie en dis met beswaarde harte wat ons aan hom sê: „Dankie, totsiens en alle voorspoed.”

Op 16 Januarie 1963 heropen die O.V.S.-skole weer, maar ongelukkig sal J. Loubser nie daar wees nie. Wie kan Grey-kollege voorstel sonder oom Koos? Wie kan homself 'n voetbaloefering voorstel sonder oom Koos en sy beroemde bloekomlatte? Daardie wonderlike en welbekende kreet met 'n belangrike wedstryd van „Komaan Grey” sal nou stil wees. Meer as dertig jaar lank het diegene wat gelukkig was om vir die eerste span te speel daardie welbekende kreet vanaf die kantlyn gehoor, en hoe 'n aansporing was dit nie gewees vir elke Grey-seun om nog daardie laaste ekstra bietjie in die stryd te werp nie. 
Sy gesonde en besliste lewenshouding en pittige humorsin het hom baie gewild en liefel gemaak onder al sy leerlinge.

hard work — all these made him a master whom boys and fellow teachers will always remember.

Sometimes there were grumbles about his "slave driving", as an aggrieved matric boy called it when his class was given "five summaries for Monday". But the grumbling was superficial because everyone knew that he would work just as hard correcting the summaries and that there was no question of his leading his troops from the rear, so to speak.

His tongue-lashings achieved a fame of their own. His bark, however, was worse than his bite, and provided that a boy did his duty, whether in class-room or on playing field, he could count on Eddie's support: but he would not tolerate a shirker.

Grey College is indeed thankful to Eddie East for ten years of devoted and enthusiastic service as a teacher, as a coach, as a splendidly thorough

organiser of tours. It wishes him well at his new school and has no doubt that under his leadership this school will become a much more serious rival to Grey, both at work and at play.

Op sy kenmerkende stil en besadigde manier



IN MEMORIAM


Op 10 Maart vanjaar is een van ons bewonende jong seuns op tragiese wyse van ons weggeneem.

THE AFRICAN HOOPOE

When people see birds, they normally ignore them, probably regarding them as being merely noisy creatures of nature. However when one sees a hoopoe one usually pauses to look at the bird before passing by.

This bird's plumage is very attractive. It has a beautiful orange colour. On its head there is a large orange crest. It has a long, thin, sharp beak. Its wings and tail are covered with dark brown and white stripes and it has an orange breast.

With their long beaks, these birds feed off insects and grubs obtained from under leaves, rotting matter and bark of trees. These insects and grubs are their staple food.

They nest in deserted termite mounds; hollow logs or tree stumps; cracks in walls, and in broken roofs. On an average, they lay four to five eggs. These are of a pale olive-green colour.

Hoopoes are mostly seen on the ground or perching low in trees. When disturbed, they fly

away with a soft flapping sound, calling "hoop-hoop."

If there are hoopoes in your garden, don't be disappointed if they disappear. They never live in the same area for any length of time.

A STORM AT SEA

Crash! I awoke with a start! The first thing I noticed was that I was drenched from head to foot. I jumped out of my bunk to find that the floor was under 6 inches of water.

I then discovered the cause of my sudden awakening. The porthole, which was made of very strong glass, had been forced in. I dressed hurriedly and ran out into the passageway. I wrenched open the door at the end of it, and gingerly groped my way along the flooded deck towards the steel ladder, which led to the bridge, while the ship rocked under my feet and the sea roared with fury. To make matters worse, we were also engulfed in dense fog.

It seemed impossible to believe that only two days ago, we had been enjoying mid-summer weather.

At about three o'clock on the previous day, the wind had sprung up, but the sea had remained calm. We had had light rain, but that was all. At about seven o'clock there had been a terrific swell on the port side. This was followed by a ten-foot wave and then it seemed as if the sea was running amuck. Wave after wave pounded against the vessel. The wind had reached tremendous force — its velocity was estimated at about one hundred and twenty miles per hour.

It was now midday, seven hours after my sudden awakening, and still there was no improvement in conditions. The wind was whipping and tearing at the superstructure of the ship, having already brought down the masts. The ship itself was creaking and shuddering under the strain.

The waves were rolling the ship like an empty barrel and all the time we were surrounded by that dense fog. The group of officers, of which I was one, were getting worried because they were afraid that the ship would break up. Later on that day we received the fatal news: the boiler-room was flooding and the pumps could not cope with the water.

The captain gave the order to send S.O.S. signals. Then the funnel collapsed and the rudder was wrenched off. By this time, the stern was dangerously low in the water and the engines were out of action. Slowly the ship's bows lifted out of the water and then the captain uttered the long expected words, "Abandon ship!"

In a short while the ship was deserted and we were pulling away in the life-boats as fast as we
